



## Jersey Use

Opeongo Minor Soccer (OMS) is committed to ensuring soccer is as cost effective for players and their families as possible. Jerseys are loaned to players to limit additional costs. Jerseys must be returned by players at the end of the season or they will be charged an additional fee.

### General Procedure

1. Opeongo Minor Soccer Jerseys will be loaned out to all players, U10 and above, for their use during the season.
2. A Jersey sign out sheet will be given to each manager to complete. This form must be returned completed, with the jerseys, at the end of the season.
3. Managers will be given a set of jerseys for the team. These are to be distributed to team players recording the jersey number for each player, at the initial practice.
4. Players are responsible to bring their jersey to all games as additional jerseys may not be available to borrow for that game. (Managers require the jersey number for each player for game sheets for U12 and above.).
5. During the season, it is the players responsibility to care for the jersey by laundering it weekly, minimizing stains and ensuring wet, soiled, sweaty uniforms are not left in gym bags and laundered appropriately.
6. At the end of the season, the player will return the jersey (unwashed is ok) to the team Manager, who will record the jerseys as being returned.
7. The Manager will return the set of jerseys, along with the completed Jersey sign out form, to the Equipment Manager for reconciliation.

### Penalty for Jerseys Not Returned

8. Players who fail to return their assigned jersey by September 1 of any year will be billed for \$25 replacement fee and will not be able to register for the family for the following year until the fee is paid.
